Power BI is a business analysis (BI) solution from Microsoft that allows you to illustrate your data using graphs and a dashboard and share insights throughout and outside the organization.

The tool allows you to connect to dozens of real-time data sources, including data that is on your network and data that is on the Internet.

- Establishment of a data model, Model Data and relationships between tables
- Writing indices in the DAX the computational engine of BI Power
- Production of reports and dashboards
